

California Notice at Collection

Last Updated: July 2026

1. Purpose of This Notice

This California Notice at Collection is provided pursuant to the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act of 2020 (collectively, the “CCPA”), and applies solely to residents of the State of California.

This Notice explains:

- The categories of Personal Information we collect;
- The purposes for which we collect and use each category of Personal Information; Whether we sell or share Personal Information; How long we retain each category of Personal Information;

2. Categories of Personal Information We Collect

The following table describes the categories of Personal Information we have collected from California residents in the preceding 12 months, and may continue to collect, whether we sell or share them, and their respective retention standards:

3. Sensitive Personal Information

We may collect the following categories of sensitive personal information:

- Social Security number, driver's license number, state identification card number, or passport number;
- Account log-in, financial account, debit card, or credit card number in combination with any required security or access code, password, or credentials;
- Precise geolocation (within 1,850 feet of a particular person);
- Racial or ethnic origin, religious or philosophical beliefs, or union membership;
- Contents of mail, email, and text messages (unless we are the intended recipient);
- Genetic data;

- Biometric information processed for the purpose of uniquely identifying an individual.

We use Sensitive Personal Information **only for the permitted business purposes specified under the CCPA** (such as providing requested services, ensuring security and integrity, and performing operational services on our behalf). We do not collect or process Sensitive Personal Information for inferring characteristics about consumers.

4. Purposes for Collection and Use

4.1 AI Processing Notice

We may process the information, documents, trademarks, designs, keywords, search queries, or other content you submit to our AI-powered intellectual property analysis tools solely for:

providing requested search and analysis services;

improving system security and performance;

troubleshooting technical issues;

generating statistical reports in an aggregated or de-identified form where permitted by applicable law.

Unless you separately agree, we do not use confidential customer documents or uploaded intellectual property materials to train publicly available AI foundation models.

4.2 We collect and use Personal Information for the following business and commercial purposes:

Purpose	Description
Provide Services	To provide, maintain, and improve our Platform and services, including account creation, customer support, and personalized content.
Communication	To send you service updates, security alerts, technical notices, and respond to your inquiries.
Transaction Processing	To process payments, billing, collections, and fulfill contractual obligations.
Service Improvement	For testing, research, analysis, and product development to improve our Platform.
Security and Fraud Prevention	To ensure security and integrity, detect and prevent fraud, and debug to identify and repair errors.
Legal Compliance	To respond to law enforcement requests and as required by applicable law, court order, or governmental regulations.

Marketing	To provide you with information about products, services, news, offers, promotions, and events (only with your consent where required).
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5. Sale or Sharing of Personal Information & Opt-Out Signals

We do not sell Personal Information for monetary consideration.

We may disclose limited categories of Personal Information, such as identifiers and Internet activity information, to analytics providers, cloud service providers, security vendors, and advertising partners solely for the purposes described in this Notice.

Where such disclosure constitutes "sharing" under the CCPA, California residents may exercise their right to opt out at any time.

Opt-Out Preference Signals:

We recognize and process Global Privacy Control (GPC) signals. If your browser or device has GPC enabled, our system will automatically process it as a valid request to opt-out of the sale or sharing of Personal Information for that browser or device.

6. Retention of Personal Information

We retain each category of Personal Information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected. The criteria used to determine retention periods include:

- The length of time we have an ongoing relationship with you and provide the Services;
- Whether there is a legal obligation to which we are subject;
- Whether retention is advisable in light of our legal position (such as applicable statutes of limitations, litigation, or regulatory investigations).

7. Your California Privacy Rights

As a California resident, you have the following rights under the CCPA:

Right	Description
Right to Know	Request disclosure of categories and specific pieces of Personal Information collected, sources, purposes, and third parties.
Right to Delete	Request deletion of your Personal Information, subject to statutory exceptions.
Right to Correct	Request correction of inaccurate Personal Information.

Right to Opt-Out	Opt-out of the sale or sharing of Personal Information for cross-context advertising.
Right to Limit	Limit the use and disclosure of Sensitive Personal Information (<i>Note: Applicable only if SPI is used beyond CCPA-permitted purposes. As stated in Section 3, we strictly limit SPI use to permitted purposes</i>).
Right to Non-Discrimination	Receive equal service and price without discriminatory treatment for exercising your rights.
